## Accountability Groups

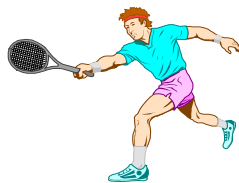

**Whatever it takes!**

The Bible Study held in October focused on being submitted enough to G-d and His purpose for our lives that we are willing to do whatever it takes to walk out the life that He has set before us! We have all been to weddings where the line was spoken, "Forsaking all others, I cleave only to..." That should be our confession as born-again, spirit-filled believers—that we are willing to forsake any and ever thing else in order to have a solid, stable relationship with the L-rd.

We discussed the fact that there is no "quick fix" or easy "formula" for that to take place in our lives. It is a daily walk. Luke 9:23 admonishes us to "take up [our] cross DAILY and follow Him." It is not something you do one time—it becomes your lifestyle. And the L-rd is so gracious that He provides what we need on a daily basis in order for us to do just that (Matt. 6:11). The more you submit yourself to this, the more you will grow in your relationship with the Father. And the better you know Him, the greater your level of trust. One thing that we took note of in this study: how well you "stand" and how well you wait on Him is directly proportional to how much you trust Him. And how much you trust Him is directly related to how much time you are willing to give Him.

Are you committed to Him and His purposes for your life? Are you willing to forsake all others in order to have a true relationship with Him? Are you willing to do whatever it takes? *F.J.*
