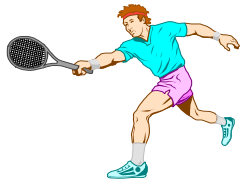
Singles interested in becoming apart of this group) for the purpose of fellowship and accountability may contact F.J.. Women will be accountable to women and men will be accountable to men.
