BHSA Co-op Code of Conduct

- Each student is responsible for governing their behavior.
- Each student will demonstrate respect for other adults and students at all times.
- Each student will respect the facilities and ensure that it is left in the condition in which it was found.
- Each student will abstain from inappropriate verbal or physical behavior.
- Each student will maintain the dress code while attending Co-op classes and Co-op sponsored events.
- Each student will use their time in Co-op classes to learn all that they can.
- Each student will refrain from any disruptive behavior that might prohibit other students from learning all they can.
- Each student will to the best of his/her ability complete the course (s) for which they enroll.
- Each student will respect and adhere to Biblical Kashrut standards while participating in Co-op activities.

BHSA Co-op Dress Code

- Any color collared golf style shirt with BHSA patch sewn on the right front chest.
- Modest pants, shorts or skirts are to be worn where no skin is shown or undergarments are shown.
- Short and skirt length is to be 1 inch below the knee when standing.
- It is preferred that boys wear a Kippa in class.
- BHSA t-shirts are not mandatory but are highly recommended for group activities.

The golf shirt is required attire for Enrichment Courses and designated events. Each family should consider purchasing 3 patches/shirts to ensure each student always has appropriate attire.

BHSA Co-op Discipline Policy

This policy is intended for the purpose of maintaining cohesive community among participants at all times. Any participant (student or adult) violating either the BHS Doctrinal Statement (by speaking against or advocating a different doctrine); the Code of Conduct or the Personal Commitments will receive warning, counseling or dismissal, whichever is deemed appropriate by the Co-op Director and or BHSA Administrator. All issues concerning dismissal will be taken before the BHS Elders prior to the recommendation for dismissal being given. In the event a student needs to be counseled this will take place in the presence of the student, parent, Co-op Director and or BHSA Administrator. Correction and restoration will always be the desire and goal of any disciplinary action.
